

## 2026 Harold G. Wolff Lecture Award

The American Headache Society's Harold G. Wolff Lecture Award is given to the best paper on headache, head or face pain, or the nature of pain itself. The recipient of this award (submitting author) will receive \$10,000 plus complimentary meeting registration, 4 nights hotel accommodations, and travel expenses for the 68th Annual Scientific Meeting, being held June 4-7, 2026, in Orlando, FL. The recipient is required to present the paper as a special lecture during the 68th Annual Scientific Meeting; if the recipient cannot attend, the lecture will not be given.

## **Eligibility:**

- 1. Manuscripts that have already been published in another journal or have already been reviewed and declined by the journal *Headache*® are ineligible for this award.
- 2. Industry-sponsored studies are ineligible for this award unless the work was investigator-initiated.

## To be considered for this award, applicants must:

- 1. Submit an abstract meeting the above eligibility criteria for consideration at the 68<sup>th</sup> Annual Scientific Meeting. <u>Submit here</u> by Monday, February 9, 2026 at 11:59 pm ET.
- 2. Submit a full manuscript to AHS Headquarters **by Monday, March 2, 2025**. The manuscript should be prepared in accordance with <u>Author Guidelines</u> as published in the journal *Headache*.

Please note papers submitted for the Wolff Award should be sent only to AHS Headquarters, and not submitted to *Headache* via Manuscript Central until **after** the recipient has been announced. All entries will be reviewed by the Editorial Board who will reach out to authors they would like to encourage to submit formally via Manuscript Central. The winning manuscript must be submitted by **May 1, 2026.** Upon submission, it will become the property of *Headache®* and will be fast-tracked for publication in an upcoming issue.
